Position Summary

The BEST Fit Project Coordinator is responsible for coordinating and managing efforts of the BEST Fit Department in providing quality nutrition education, physical fitness and health awareness programs to all LA's BEST sites.

Responsibilities

- Work collaboratively with team members to develop, deliver and manage quality health and wellness programs and events
- Assist with delivering professional development for out-of-school time staff
- Provide technical assistance to site-based staff and traveling staff
- Order, inventory, and coordinate distribution of supplies and equipment
- Collect and maintain appropriate information, files, and records
- Review, evaluate, and provide feedback regarding programs and projects
- Other duties as assigned.

- A minimum of 4 years of experience in health, recreation, education or related field
- Knowledge and understanding of the needs of a diverse student population
- Familiar with criteria for quality after school programs and the youth development philosophy
- Demonstrated skills in working collaboratively with school personnel and community partners
